Delaney Park Hockey Rink

The Gomez Foundation has rebuilt three of the four outdoor rinks in the Anchorage Parks system in the last four years. This will be the final rink to rebuild. The Tikishla Park outdoor hockey rink was rebuilt in 2006. The Mulcahy outdoor hockey rinks were rebuilt in 2014.

The Gomez Foundation and Anchorage Park Foundation have built a strong partnership, which will benefit the efficiency and quality of this project. Private contributions include many volunteer hours because the hockey community will rally around this significant project. Rehabilitating the hockey rink at Delaney Park will bring new life to the beloved park strip. This rink is well used by neighbors in South Addition, employees of downtown businesses, and the greater Anchorage Community because of its convenient downtown location

Anchorage has 10,946 acres of municipal parkland, 223 parks, and over 250 miles of trails and greenbelts that link neighborhoods with surrounding natural open space and wildlife habitat. These are considerable assets for the citizens of Anchorage to enjoy and maintain.
