VIRTUAL EVENT FAQs

1. What is a Virtual Event?

A virtual event is a walking/running/biking event that you can complete anytime/anyplace! The best part of a virtual event is convenience - you decide what works best for you. Complete your event distance on your favorite trails, in your neighborhood, at the gym, or anywhere. Then share your experience with us by email, social media and in your RunSignup Profile. It's better together!

2. How long do I have to complete my 5K, 10K, Mini Moose, or Mighty Moose?

You will have from September 23 - September 30, 2022, to complete your event.

3. What is the Moose Loop?

The Moose Loop is a destination trail that connects Anchorage, AK. Our four main multi-use trails—the Lanie Fleischer Chester Creek Trail, the Tony Knowles Coastal Trail, the Campbell Creek Trail, and the Ship Creek Trail—can be connected to each other to form a 32-mile bike loop, an almost-complete urban greenway that is, when viewed on a map, in the shape of a moose! It's an iconic Anchorage experience to be done in a day or over a year.

4. How do I purchase a Moose Loop shirt?

Moose Loop event shirts can be purchased from the event store during online registration or at event packet pickup while supplies last. Shirts are not included with registration and can be purchased without event registration. [Purchase shirts here](#). All shirts purchased with event registration will be included in the event packet, available at packet pickup or mailed if you selected the option to be mailed.

5. How will I pick up my event packet?

6. How long do I have to upload my Results?

You will have from September 23 – October 7, 2022, to upload your results.

7. How do I upload my Results?

- **Search for your registration by First & Last Name OR Email & Birth Date**
- Select, **SUBMIT VIRTUAL RESULTS**
- **Enter your time manually or by uploading a .TIF or .GPX file.**

8. Do I need to submit results?

You do not have to submit a time. You can indicate that you completed the event without providing a time.

9. Do I have a bib?

Yes, each participant will receive a physical bib with registration in event packets.

You can print your own bib by logging into your [RunSignup](#) profile and view and/or download your personalized virtual bib.
